Items accepted only as new (unused):

Bedroom/Bathroom Items

- Bath towels, hand towels, & wash cloths
- Bed Pillows
- Blankets/comforters & bed sheets (*twin- & queen-size*)
- Shower curtains & curtain rings
- Toilet paper

Cleaning/Storage Supplies

- All-purpose cleaning solutions (*counters, floors, windows*)
- Dish soap
- Foil, plastic wrap & storage bags
- Kitchen trash bags
- Laundry detergent
- Toilet brushes

Hygiene Supplies

- Body & hand soap
- Deodorant
- Diapers & wipes
- Feminine hygiene supplies
- Hair brushes, combs, & razors
- Shampoo & conditioner
- Toothpaste & toothbrushes

Items accepted as new or gently used:

Kitchen Items

- Casserole dishes/food storage containers
- Clean trash cans
- Coffee pots, blenders, toasters, & crock pots
- Cooking utensils (*spatulas, spoons, can openers, measuring cups*)
- Counter-top microwave ovens
- Dinner plates/bowls/dish sets
- Plastic & glass drink ware
- Pots & pans
- Silverware

Laundry/Cleaning Items

- Irons & ironing boards
- Laundry baskets
- Vacuum cleaners, brooms, mops, & buckets

Bathroom Items

- Clean trash cans
- Soap dishes/dispensers
- Tooth brushes & toothbrush holders
